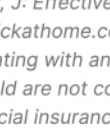
- My urinary incontinence symptoms include: _____ (For example: during the day vs. night, how often they occur)

You can begin your discussions about urinary incontinence with your primary care provider. Your provider may also refer you to a specialist if they decide you need a different treatment or additional diagnosis. These specialists are usually urologists, who specialize in urinary issues in men and women, or a urogynecologist, who specializes in the urinary system.
